**A. Description:**

The SCNLA Trade Show Intern Program was initiated to increase the interaction between the nursery and landscape industry and College horticulture students, The South Carolina Nursery and Landscape Association will provide hotel accommodations (double occupancy) and conference registration and the recipients will perform various hands on work assignments during the conference.
